Monday 20:00-22:00 4 <sup>th</sup> Sep.	<b>Welcome Meal</b>	Cold buffet: Salmon mousse followed by a selection of meats and cheeses with salad and then crème brûlée. Accompanied by a glass of wine or mineral water. <i>No vegetarian-specific or lactose free option but you can order from the takeaway and join the party.</i>	£15	17€		
Tuesday 11:00-17:00 5 <sup>th</sup> Sep.	<b>Noirmoutier</b> <i>Featuring Le Jardin du Vent and L'île aux Papillons</i>	We firstly visit the Garden of Wind ( <a href="#">Le Jardin du Vent</a> ), stopping for a picnic lunch (bring your own or pre-order from the takeaway). Then, we go on to the Island of Noirmoutier to visit the Garden of Butterflies ( <a href="#">L'île aux Papillons</a> ). In the heart of a tropical greenhouse maintained at 26°C, walk among hundreds of butterflies from around the world, among the most extraordinary plants and flowers in the largest butterfly greenhouse in France. Also enter the space of the loriquets, the aviary dedicated to these delightfully colourful and curious little parrots.	£9 <hr/> with minibus £26	10€ <hr/> with minibus 30€		
Wednesday 9:00-16:00 6 <sup>th</sup> Sep.	<b>Les Sables-d'Olonne</b> <i>Les Salines, plus explore the town</i>	We start with a boat tour through ' <a href="#">Les Salines</a> ' the salt marshes of L'Olonne. For about 8km along the water, the boat takes you to the golden century of the Salines. The organized visit stops at the Parc d'Aventure du sel and talk about the fabulous odyssey of white gold. Explore the town of <a href="#">Les Sables D'Olonne</a> for lunch (bring money), see the shell frescoes, the Tower of Arundel, the beach, art museum, and much more. <i>Limited availability: please book as soon as possible</i>	£21 <hr/> with minibus £39	24€ <hr/> with minibus 44€		
Wednesday 20:00-22:00 6 <sup>th</sup> Sep.	<b>Japanese Meal</b>	Travel to the country of the rising sun with this two-course meal. Duck Tataki served with fruits and rice. White wine and sake, Brownie with vanilla ice cream. <i>Vegetarian and lactose free options available; no nut free option but you can order from the takeaway and join the party.</i>	£15	17€		

Thursday 7 <sup>th</sup> Sep. 11:00–17:00	<b>Sion</b> <i>Sea-view restaurant and bowling or coastal walk</i>	Visit a sea view restaurant ( <a href="#">201 Forest Avenue</a> ) for lunch in nearby Sion. After lunch go for a stroll along the coastal path (La Corniche) or stay in the building for a game of ten-pin bowling. Prebooking is necessary for transport and for reserving a seat at the restaurant. Friday Evening 8 <sup>th</sup> Sep. 20:00-22:00	<b>Indian Meal</b>	Enjoy the hidden beauty of India in this delicious two-course meal. Chicken tikka-masala (mild spice), fine IPA beer, rice pudding. <i>Vegetarian option: falafel tikka-masala. Traces of nuts. Saturday Full Day 9 <sup>th</sup> Sep. 08:15-18:30	<b>L'île de Yeux</b>	The rugged and picturesque <a href="#">L'île de Yeux</a> island is accessed via a scenic 60-minute <a href="#">boat trip</a> from St Gilles. Upon arrival in Port Joinville, we will be free to explore the town with its shops and eateries. To see the sights of the island, hire a bike or take ' <a href="#">Le Petit train</a> ' road train for a 2-hour tour of the island's highlights, including the Old Castle, the Pointe du Châtelet, the Sabias beach and the Port de la Meule. <i>Limited availability: please book as soon as possible.</i>	<b>£37</b> with minibus <b>£46</b>	<b>42€</b> with minibus <b>52€</b>
